JMG offers **financial literacy training** for teens and young adults supported by the foster care system. The **Opportunity Passport®** program's financial literacy training helps young people gain skills related to personal finances.

Participants earn a **ONE-TIME \$100 STIPEND** upon completion of two virtual 90-minute training sessions.



To be eligible for **Opportunity Passport®**, participants must be:

- At least 14 but younger than 26 years old
- Currently in foster care or in foster care for at least one day since turning 14
- Have access to the internet as training is currently virtual
- Participants must have a bank account and a reliable ongoing source of income
